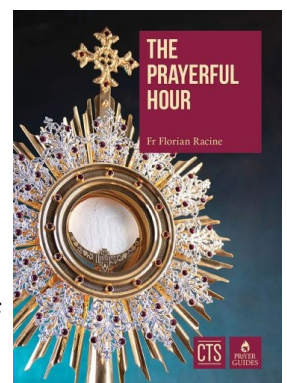
Pilgrimage of Hope for the Jubilee Year
