Parish Financial Statement (summary)

- The parish financial statement has been prepared by the DF Dillon @ Co., Accountants.
 It has been examined and approved by the finance committee. Copies are available in the church – please bring one home with you.
- The accounts show a surplus this year of €50,556, compared with a surplus of €19,858 the previous year. The weekly basket collection is up 7% on last year. The envelopes and shrines are also up over €10,000 on last year. Contributions by standing order or direct debit are much appreciated. The details are on the parish website and published here (below).
- The finance committee is attentive to the rising costs relating to the parish Meals on Wheels. The parish has employed two new people to work in Meals on Wheels since Nora retired after an incredible service to the parish for over 25 years. Meals on Wheels relies heavily on fundraising and donations from a wide range of groups in the parish and we are asking parishioners to keep this necessary and important parish project in mind.
