Proposed Amalgamation of St. Mary's National School and St. Michael's National School, Trim

The Department of Education has confirmed the decision, approved by the Patron Bishop Deenihan, that St Mary's and St Michael's will be amalgamated into one single school. This decision comes at the end of a lengthy consultation process involving the Boards of Management, staff, parents and pupils. The independent assessor noted that there is overwhelming support for the amalgamation.

The Department and Patron have agreed that the new school will be known as Scoil Naomh Pádraig and the amalgamation will take effect next September. The new name reminds students and families of their rootedness in a faith tradition that has deep historical ties to the parish in which they live and learn. This name also encourages liturgical and spiritual education in celebrating St. Patrick, his mission, his virtues, and his connection to our local community. St Patrick's story embodies the values central to Catholic education: faith, service, perseverance, and spreading the Gospel.

The parish is grateful to all who participated in the amalgamation process and, in particular, the Principals and Boards of Management. We will keep you informed as the process continues.

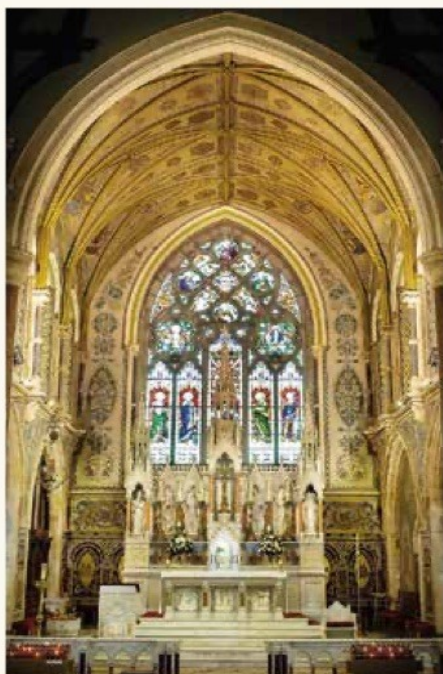
