Remembering two priests

Fr Colm Murtagh was born on 17 October 1925 and was a native of Coole, Co. Westmeath. He was ordained in 1950. Fr Murtagh served in the parishes of Oldcastle, Mullingar and Ballivor before being appointed as hospital chaplain in Navan in 1953. He served in Ratoath, Eglisk, Enfield and Rochfortbridge before his appointment as Parish Priest of Kildalkey in January 1981. He retired in 2005 and continued to reside in the parish.

Fr Patrick O'Rafferty died in California. He was a native of Clonard and studied for the priesthood at St. Kieran's College, Kilkenny. Ordained in 1953, he served in the diocese of Sacramento USA until his retirement. He was a regular visitor home over the years and celebrated his Diamond Jubilee of ordination in 2013.
