Easter appeal for an orphanage in Rwanda



Following the 1994 genocide in Rwanda, Pope St John Paul II asked for an orphanage to be set up in the city of Mbare in Rwanda to provide for children who lost their families in the violence and war. Today, around 400 children live at the orphanage where they are given food, shelter, education, care and, just as importantly, the certainty that they are not alone. The latest step in the development is the building of a new facility in the orphanage. It will cost €160,000 and the team in charge of the development are

asking for support from Catholic parishes, including Trim and Boardsmill. If you are in a position to help, no matter how big or small, it would be much appreciated and Fr Paul will ensure it goes directly to Rwanda and you will receive regular updates on the building project. This is a generous way to respond to the words of Pope Leo XIV during Lent: "let us ask God for the grace to be more attentive to God and to the least fortunate so that the suffering are welcomed and loved". Pope Leo XIV calls for Easter truce

"Easter should be the holiest, most sacred time of the year. It is a time of peace, a time for much reflection, but as we all know, once again in the world, in so many places, we are seeing so much suffering, so many deaths, even innocent children" Pope Leo said. He asked everyone "especially Christians," to "live these days recognising that Christ is still crucified today, that Christ still suffers today in the innocent, especially those who are suffering from violence, hatred, and war. Let us pray for them, for the victims of war, let us pray that there may truly be a new, renewed peace, which can give new life to all."
