It is a spiritual journey towards a deepening relationship with Jesus Christ. As aspirants move forward through prayer, reflection, Scripture, storytelling, questioning and works of charity, our parish will accompany them on their faith journey. Summer is a timely opportunity for parishes to promote RCIA among parishioners and prospective candidates. Ideally, the process of inquiry and instruction should commence in early autumn. The process for aspirants who have never been baptised should culminate at the Easter Vigil. The process for candidates who have been baptised in another Christian denomination should culminate at Pentecost with the celebration of First s
