From the Letter from Bishop Deenihan to Confirmation children

The important point is that Confirmation is a Sacrament and I would ask you to spend some time on the religious nature of Confirmation. Pope Leo has described the Church as the 'Community of the friends of Jesus'. These are the Saints. For Saint Paul, the Saint is a person who believes that Jesus is the Son of God and who lives a life of faith hope and love by being part of the life of the Church. We are called to be Saints!

In Confirmation, your faith and membership of the Church is 'confirmed' and you take responsibility for your own faith in terms of praying, attending Mass and the Sacraments and living the kind of life that God wants us to live. You could start that now! Remember that quotation from Pope Leo, 'The Church is the community of the friends of Jesus'. You become a closer friend of Jesus through Confirmation! Friendships must be worked on. We can't take our friends for granted! Work on your friendship with Jesus. A good way of doing that would be to pray each night before bed and to attend Mass on Sundays. I know that your parents and grandparents would be able to support you in this task too.

I know that many of you will be having a celebration afterwards. That celebration does not have to be extravagant or expensive. Confirmation should not put pressure on anyone or make anyone feel unhappy. Don't put pressure on those at home in relation to the celebration or the party.
