As we celebrate the Jubilee Year of Hope, a special 40 Hours of Eucharistic Adoration will take place in the Cathedral of Christ the King, Mullingar, from Friday 21st to Sunday 23rd November, concluding on the Solemnity of Christ the King. Adoration will begin after Mass on Friday 21st November at 7:30 pm and conclude at 4 pm with sung Vespers and Benediction on Sunday 23rd November, with Bishop Alan Mc Guckian SJ as homilist. There will be confessions from noon until midnight on Saturday 22nd November.
