Pope Leo at Youth Mass

The Lord is gently knocking at the window of your soul

Last Sunday Pope Leo celebrated Mass for 1 million young Catholics with 7,000 priests and 450 bishops. In this homily, the Holy Father said:



"There is a burning question in our hearts, a need for truth that we cannot ignore, which leads us to ask ourselves: what is true happiness? What is the true meaning of life? What can free us from being trapped in meaninglessness, boredom and mediocrity? The fullness of our lives does not depend on what we store up or, as we heard in the Gospel, on what we possess. Rather happiness has to do with what we joyfully welcome and share. We need to lift our eyes, to look upwards, to the 'things that are above'. It is Jesus who stirs in you the desire to do something great with your lives. Let us remain united to Him, let us remain in His friendship, through prayer, adoration, Eucharistic Communion, frequent Confession, and generous charity."
