Pope Leo XIV on Artificial Intelligence



The Holy Father published last week his first major document, entitled "Magnifica Humanitas". It focuses on questions relating to how humanity can respond to the development of artificial intelligence (AI). The encyclical is not a call to reject AI. It is a call to guide the use of AI toward the magnificence of humanity.

Pope Leo XIV notes that "when efficiency becomes the ultimate measure of value, human beings are tempted to see themselves as a project to be optimized rather than as persons called to relationship and communion". This means asking practical questions about AI-assisted technology in ordinary daily life:

- Does it help me remain faithful to the truth, despite the most appealing content?
- Does it help educate me and allow me to educate others?
- Does it help me cultivate genuine closeness in relationships and cherish places and times where physical presence remains crucial?
- Does it help me participate in the promotion of justice and peace?
