**Archbishop Dermot Farrell offered Mass for those unlawfully killed in the Stardust fire**

The Archbishop celebrated the Mass last weekend in Bonnybrook. In his homily, he described the courage and persistence of their search for truth and justice as dignified and inspirational. "Their solidarity with one another sustained a hope for truth that was otherwise denied them for so long. "The truth will set you free" (John 8:23). How do we recognise truth? We recognise truth by its capacity to heal broken lives and to help the families and communities to rebuild. The truth that emerged from the inquest enables families to deal with what happened in the inferno over four decades ago and puts them on a road to freedom.
